# all purpose cleaner

Vinegar Water Dish Soap Spray Bottle

Fill spray bottle half full of vinegar Add a squirt of dish soap Top up with water

Spray surfaces to be cleaned and wipe with rag of choice

## scrubs

### Baking Soda

Sprinkle onto area to be scrubbed. Scrub gently with cloth or sponge and rinse well

### Baking Soda Dish Soap

Mix dish soap with enough baking soda to make a paste Apply to area to be scrubberd Scrub gently with cloth or sponge, and rinse well This one is great for greasy messes

# disinfectant spray

### Hydrogen Peroxide (3%) Spray Nozzel

This is a super easy and effective disinfectant. Take your bottle of hydrogen peroxide and attatch a spray nozzel right to the brown bottle.

Hydrogen Peroxide is light sensitive and will break down over time.

Spray your surfaces\* and let it fizz.
When the fizzing stops wipe with rag.
Repeat if neccesary

\*test on inconspicuous area first.

### oven cleaner

### Vinegar Baking Soda

Boil vinegar in kettle

Pour into a heat proof bowl and place in middle of oven. Close door and leave for about and hour or two. Remove bowl, but don't dump yet.

Sprinkle baking soda onto bottom of oven and scrub. Sprinkle with warm vinegar and allow to sit for an hour. Go back and wipe clean.

## microwave cleaner

#### Vinegar Water

Put one cup vinegar and one cup water in a microwave safe bowl

Microwave on high for 5 minutes Let stand for 15 minutes

Wipe clean

## glass cleaner

### Vinegar Water Spray Bottle

Fill spray bottle half full of vinegar Top up with water

Spray window, mirrors or other glass items with the spray and wipe with a microfiber rag, a glass cleaing rag, or homemade rags (old flannel baby blankets make great glass cleaning cloths)
